



# GAME DAY EXPECTATIONS TEAM OFFICIALS



## COACH

### THE EXPECTATIONS OF COACHES ON GAME DAY ARE

- ✓ **DO** hold the correct accreditation for the age group you are coaching
- ✓ **DO** ensure your name is written clearly on the Sign on Sheet as COACH
- ✓ **DO** make sure minimum game time requirements for players are met (if required)
- ✓ **DO** support the Ground Manager to control any negative spectator behaviour from your supporters
- ✗ **DON'T** call out to players or give instructions from the bench
- ✗ **DON'T** leave the bench or enter the field of play for any reason
- ✗ **DON'T** approach or speak to the Referee

## TEAM MANAGER

### THE EXPECTATIONS OF TEAM MANAGERS ON GAME DAY ARE

- ✓ **DO** ensure your name is written clearly on the Sign on Sheet as MANAGER
- ✓ **DO** present player and team staff ID cards to Ground Manager for sign on process prior to kick off
- ✓ **DO** ensure that all sections of the Sign on Sheet are completed correctly
- ✓ **DO** take a photo of your Sign on Sheet before you leave
- ✓ **DO** write **HIA** next to the players name on the Sign on Sheet for anyone removed from the field with a suspected head injury
- ✓ **DO** support the Ground Manager to control any negative spectator behaviour from your supporters
- ✗ **DON'T** call out to players or give instructions from the managers table
- ✗ **DON'T** approach or speak to the Referee

## SPORTS TRAINERS

### THE EXPECTATIONS OF SPORTS TRAINERS ON GAME DAY ARE

- ✓ **DO** hold a current accreditation for your team as per the NRL On-Field Policy
- ✓ **DO** ensure your name is written clearly on the Sign on Sheet as TRAINER
- ✓ **DO** stay at the bench at all times, unless undertaking your specific role
- ✓ **DO** follow the NRL On-Field Policy and only enter the field during breaks of play (after a try or when the Referee signals time off) or when a player needs attention or when assisting with an interchange
- ✓ **DO** ensure that any player removed from the field with a suspected head injury is given a completed **NRL – Community Head Injury Recognition and Referral Form**
- ✗ **DON'T** approach or speak to the Referee
- ✗ **DON'T** enter the field during a scrum
- ✗ **DON'T** let players share drink bottles
